Introduction

The setup station was created to help manage setups within a team and make them freely available to all team members.




The files in the zip will help you setup the station as a “**standalone**” website. Modifications to the files will be required if you are to run it in a wrapper of another site, your web developer should be able to do this. We have successfully integrated the setup station in [Joomla](#) version 1.0.8 using the com_wrapper.

Requirements

Web Server : PHP and My SQL enabled

Web Space : Approx 2Mb

Installation

Please keep the file names and the folder structure the same

- Unzip the files to a folder on your hard drive
- Edit the following lines in the file “page.class.php” located in the “includes” folder.

var \$domain = “http://your url here/folder”;

Enter the website address the site is to be located. Include any sub folder without the trailing slash

var \$logfile = “Name of your logo file”;

Enter the name of the logo file to be displayed in the top left of the page. To keep the symmetry of the site it is a good idea to make the logo file roughly the same size of the lfslogo.jpg file located in the images folder and place your logo in the images folder.

var \$logolink = “http://Team Website”;

Enter the web address the logo file is to go to when clicked

var \$maintitle = ”Title for Setup Station”;

Enter the text you wish to appear in the title bar of the window

var \$keywords = “Setup Station, Team Setup Station”;

Enter the keywords you wish to use to describe your team setup station. These are used by some search engines.

var \$description = “Describe the site”;

Enter a description of the site. Again used by search engines

var \$dbhost = “Host Name”;

Enter the name of the My SQL host

var \$dbuser = “Username”;

Enter the username required to access the My SQL host

var \$dbpswd = “Password”;

Enter the password required to access the My SQL host

var \$dbname = “Database Name”;

Enter the name of the database you will install the setup station tables to.

var \$guest = “false”;

Enter True to enable the Guest account. Disabled by default

var \$pubstatsPremium = “false”;

Change to true if you pay for un-tar-pitted LFS World statistics. For more details visit <http://www.lfsworld.net>. Logon and go to the Pubstats Access tab in the My LFSW Settings icon on the desktop.

var \$pubstatsVersion = “1.2”;

I have tested using this version.

var \$pubstatsIdentKey = "Ident Key";

This is required to get the statistics from LFS World.

For more details visit <http://www.lfsworld.net>. Logon and go to the Pubstats Access tab in the My LFSW Settings icon on the desktop.

- If you intend to use the setup station with a dark background then you will need to change the following line in the "general.class.php" file
From : case 7 : \$type = "#808080"; return \$type; Break;
To : case 7 : \$type = "#FFFFFF"; return \$type; Break;
- Upload the SQL file located in the Install folder to your My SQL database. This creates the tables and populates the Car, Track, and adds an Admin User to the users table
- Upload the files and folders you have just amended to your website location, excluding the install folder. You may need to use "chmod 777" command on the setups folder
- Open the website and you should be presented with a login screen enter using the username "admin" and the password "admin".
- Congratulations you now have a place to store your teams LFS setups.

N.B

The Blackwood Car Park is not included in the tracks table as it is not used by the majority of teams. Should you wish to add it then here is the data to enter.

Track Name : Blackwood Car Park

Administration

Team Members

There is a default admin login, I suggest you either change the password or delete it once you have added your team members.

Username : admin
Password : admin

- Login to the setup station with the username & password above. (the login screen will appear to reload before you are redirected to the first page)
- Click on the “*Add Member*” link to display a list of all members
- Click the “*Add*” button at the bottom of the list of members
- The following fields **MUST** be completed for the member to be added
 - Username - Name used to login to the setup station
 - LFS Name - Name registered with on LFS. (Case sensitive)
 - In Game Name - Name used when Online (e.g. T7R|D34N0)
 - Encrypted Password - Type the password as normal and it will be encrypted when the member is added
 - User Level - Default is 2.
Set to 1 If the member is to be an
Set to 3 If member only allowed to upload
 - Language - Default is English.

Using this one link you are able to Add, Update and delete team member details

Car Name Data

Should a new car be added or the car name changes in any way you will be able to add/change the details using the Cars Table link.

Here is a description of the data to be contained in the fields when adding or changing details

- Car - The three character code of the car. As displayed in LFS World within Racers & Hosts online
- Name - Name given as displayed in the Cars screen of the game
- Name In Setup - The name at the start of the setup file up to the first Underscore. Not all are the same see the Race About.
e.g. **BMW SAUBER**_as1_WorldRecord.set

Track Name Data

Should a new track be added or the track name changes in any way you will be able to add/change the details using the Tracks Table link.

Here is a description of the data to be contained in the fields when adding or changing details

User Guide

The way the pages displaying tables of setups are very similar. To determine the page you are on check the navigation links on the left of the page, the page you are on will not have a link (not underlined).

To locate setups by car, car & track or other criteria, click the Search button and enter your selection then click the query button. A new link above the table will be displayed allowing you to download the setups you have just requested. Click the Clear button to reset the selection criteria and the table.

Quick Find

The initial page shows all the setups with a setup indicated by a green tick. Clicking on the tick will take you to a page displaying the setups available for that combo. Links are also displayed to download them

Find a Setup

The initial page shows all the setups within the station. To download a setup click on it's name in the table. There is also a link above the table to download all the setups in the station.

When you request setups for a specific car & track the station will display your personal best, Hot Lap and the World record


Upload a Setup

This page will allow you to add (upload) a setup to the station and displays all the setups within the station.

To add a set to the station click the Add button. A page asking for setup details is displayed. Complete the form and click the Save button to return to the initial upload page, click More to add more setups or click cancel to return to the initial upload page discarding any data in the form.

Rename a Setup


This page will allow you to rename or change the data of a setup within the station and displays all the setups within the station

To rename/change the setup data click the change icon () next to the setup. In the form change the data. Complete the form and click the Save button to return to the initial rename page, click Apply to add more setups or click cancel to return to the initial upload page discarding any data in the form.

NOTE: When changing the name within the setup file name only change the characters between the First underscore and the last dot, keeping to a maximum of 15 characters.

Delete a Setup

This page will allow you to delete a setup from the station and displays all the setups within the station.

To delete setup data click the delete icon () next to the setup. A screen will now show the setup selected. Click the Delete button to return to the initial delete setup page, click cancel to return to the initial delete page discarding any data in the form.

NOTE: When deleting the record and the file will be deleted from the station

Update Fuel Data

Here you can add, change or delete and search fuel consumption data for a specific car and track combination.

Setups Required

The initial page shows all the setups with a setup indicated by a green tick. This is the same page as displayed by Quick Find

Latest Uploads

This page displays all the setups within the station in date order from the newest to the oldest. You are still able to download and search the station from this page as described in the Find a Setup section of the manual.

Change Profile

You are able to change your password and other details from this page including the language you wish to view the setup station in.

Car/Track Codes

If you are unsure of the three character car codes or the track codes used within the station then this page will display the list.
